
Army Personnel Testing (APT)

What tests are available and how may I qualify?

- Eligibility
 - Currently serving in the Kentucky National Guard or other component
 - Have completed the required wait period between retests (see back)
- Tests Available
 - Armed Forces Classification Test (AFCT)
 - To raise ASVAB scores and further career (e.g. MOS change, OCS)
 - Selection Instrument Flight Training (SIFT) Test
 - Required to participate in Army aviation training programs
 - Defense Language Proficiency Test (DLPT)
 - To certify proficiency level in 65+ languages
 - Annual requirement for Foreign Language Proficiency Bonus pay
 - Defense Language Aptitude Battery (DLAB)
 - Required to attend Army foreign language school (DLIFLC)

When is testing available?

- Testing is provided in <u>Frankfort</u> by appointment only, generally on Tuesdays
 - Army Soldiers should contact their unit to request a test.
 - Army units submit a DA 4187, to the ATCO listed above with-
 - Test name and date last taken
 - GT score must be provided for AFCT and SIFT requests.
 - Soldier's name, preferred email, and phone number
 - Commander (or delegate) should mark "Is Approved" and sign. Soldier may sign on test day.
 - Templates are available from the TCO or onlinehttps://gko.portal.ng.mil/states/KY/G1/SitePages/Education.aspx
 - TCO will call Soldier to schedule and email confirmation of date/time.
 - Non-Army service members should contact the ATCO (at the top) regarding what documentation is necessary for their component and desired test.

How often can I retest?

- AFCT: minimum 6 months between retests
- SIFT: minimum 45 days between retest (allowed two attempts total)
- **DLPT**: minimum 9 months between retests on same language
- **DLAB**: minimum 6 months between retests, members who score a 95 are permitted one retest if needed to fulfill a requirement for higher language category
