

## What Is It?

An academically accepted document approved by the American Council on Education (ACE) to validate a service member's military occupational experience and training along with the corresponding ACE college credit recommendations.

## **How Do I Qualify?**

 All Military Members, current or former are eligible to receive a JST

## What Do I Get?

- The JST helps college registrars award college credit for learning gained in the military.
- The JST provides a description of military schooling and work history in civilian language and serves as a counseling tool for academic and career counselors in advising Service members and veterans.
- The JST saves time and money by recommending the award of college credits, which means less tuition to pay and less time spent in the classroom.
- The acceptance of ACE credit recommendations varies depending on an institution's policies, procedures, and degree requirements.

## **How Do I Apply?**

- ◆ Submit your official JST to any institution located on the "Official Transcript Request" page
- If you are missing an ACE accredited course you completed more than two months ago and it is an ACE accredited course, send a copy of all training certificate documentation (DA-1059) and justification through the JST website.
