**Credentialing Assistance (CA)** 

### 1. What Is It?

The Army's Credentialing Assistance (CA) Program provides Soldiers with funding for more than 2,100 credentials listed on the Army Credentialing Opportunities On-Line website (COOL): https://www.cool.osd.mil/army.

## 2. How Do I Qualify?

- > Issued a CAC card.
- Cannot be flagged.
- ➤ Have an active ArmylgnitED account
- Be able to finish the training/exam at least 31 days prior to ETS or MRD.
- ➤ No service obligation for Officers using Credentialing Assistance after 13 OCT 21.

### 3. What Do I Get?

- > CA provides up to \$2,000/per FY to complete any 1 credential of your choice each year.
  - Aviation certifications limited to \$1,000
  - May fund up to 3 credentials within a 10-year period of service
- > Soldiers may use Federal Tuition Assistance (FTA) and Credentialing Assistance (CA); however, the combined usage shall not exceed \$4,500 per FY.
- > CA can be used for any credential listed on Army COOL: https://www.cool.osd.mil/army.
  - Click "Find a Credential"
- CA will pay expenses for classroom, hands-on, online/blended training and associated materials to include: manuals, study guides, textbooks, processing fees, test fees, related fees for continuing education requirements, and recertification of credentials.
- > Soldiers must pass the certification exam within 180 days of course completion.
- Credentialing Assistance and GI Bill may not be used at the same time to pay for the certification.

## 5. How Do I Apply?

- ➤ Contact Mr. Bolin, Education Services Specialist, to discuss the CA application process and verify eligibility.
- Ensure your credential is listed on Army Cool at: <a href="https://www.cool.osd.mil/army">www.cool.osd.mil/army</a>
- Create an ArmylgnitED account, create an account at: www.armyignited.army.mil
  - When the ArmylgnitED site launches, click Get Started
- Once your account is created, log on and select Add Credential Path
- > Once your path is in the system, you will click **Request Credentialing Assistance** and select the credential path your request relates to,
- Follow the four easy steps to create your Credentialing Assistance request and select your training provider/vendor.
- ➤ If your training provider/vendor does not appear in the list of approved vendors, Clicking **Don't see a related vendor?** will allow you to send an email to ACCESS for more information regarding the missing vendor.
- ➤ IMPORTANT! CA is paid up front. Soldiers will NOT be reimbursed for any payments made to the training provider.
- > ACCESS Army University will notify Soldiers directly if approved/disapproved.
- ➤ All CA requests must be submitted no later than 30 business days (45 calendar days), prior to course start date, no exceptions.

## 6. Where Can I Go For Testing?

- > Testing locations vary based on the exam. Check with your credentialing agency to find out where they offer testing.
- There are two major companies that offer certification and licensure exams. You can find local test centers on their websites:

# 7. May I transfer Credentialing Assistance to dependents?

➤ CA may be used by current Soldiers only. However, certifications listed with the GI Bill icon (♠) are also reimbursable from VA (exam only). This is useful for dependents and spouses transferred Post 9-11 GI Bill.
