



More services provided under unrestricted reporting option

Chain of Command

No Contact Order between Service Members

Can move either victim or perpetrator to another unit

Possible to do split drills if requested and deemed appropriate

Possible to set aside Collateral Misconduct until final disposition of case

Imposes any UCMJ or other actions when advised by legal against perpetrator if other avenues are unavailable

Expedited Transfer if requested

Other as needed

Investigatory Agency (CID, OSI, MP, Provost Marshall, Civilian Law Enforcement, NGB Office of Complex Investigations, other)

"Titles" case for investigation

Conducts investigation

Agencies such as law enforcement and Provost Marshall do protective orders

Completes investigation after all interviews and collection of evidence/testimonies.

Determines whether case is "founded" or "unfounded". If unfounded, states why.

Turns results over to legal

Other as needed

Legal

Advises victim of the legal steps to be taken

Uses results of investigation to proceed with prosecution in either civilian or military courts

Keeps victim and VA informed of all happenings with case

Other as needed

Victim Witness Liaison
– MIL Justice or Court
Advocate – Civ Justice

Apprises victim of rights

Provides documents and updates for case prosecution

Provides victim with documents to select to be notified in cases of incarceration, parole or release

Other as needed

Regional Rape Crisis Center (Civilian agency)

Other Civilian Agencies (e.g. Veterans Affairs, Family Advocacy,

Community Shelters, etc)

NOTE:

Check with commander of personnel under charges, restraint, or investigation for sexual assault to ensure they are flagged IAW AR 600-8-2 and that their security clearances are suspended IAW AR 380-67 or AFI 31-305 /AFGM 1.1 Chapter 8

NOTE:

Information must be collected by the SARC from VA, and other responders/sources, and input into DSAIDS, SADMS, and/or GKO at least monthly

UPDATES / FOLLOW-UP TIMELINE

<u>Updates required to LTC and/or</u> higher commander:

- 14 days after report
- Monthly thereafter

Updates to victim:

- 30 days prior to destruction of SAFE kit in a restricted report, must contact victim and let them know
- monthly basis on investigation status until final disposition
- Follow-up with victim 45 days after disposition of the case

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
